Brunner set to hire for new Orleans County plant

With its \$15 million expansion complete in Medina, Canadian truck axle manufacturer Brunner International Inc. is looking build its workforce.

The Niagara Falls, Ont.-based company — and Orleans County's largest employer, built a 48,000 square-foot building at its 3959 Bates Road site to house an expansion for its axle production facility.

Brunner vice president [Bradley MacDonald](#) said that the company, which manufactures axle shafts and brake components, had gained market share in recent years.

This led to the need for the new facility, which MacDonald said could lead to opportunities to manufacture products in other industries.

The company operates an affiliate facility in Niagara Falls, Canada and employs about 500. Of those, more than 400 work at the Medina facility, which is hiring for its myriad product lines, which include S-cams and brake shoes for tractor trailers. Among the positions that are open include CNC machine operators, quality inspectors and material handlers.
